
Dear Coileen:

Enclosed is a copy of a letter which I received from Father Lang at the end of June, which I inadvertently forgot to pass on to you. In this letter dated June 30, 2007, he, of course, argues with me over whether there is a stay under Canon Law. However, most significantly he puts in writing in the third paragraph on the first page of this letter that the Diocese will take "no action related to the future of the Church buildings until the related issues are concluded." I take it that this is his artful way of saying in writing what he told me orally - that they will not sell the property until after the recourse in Rome has been resolved. That may be as close as you may get to written assurance along these lines.

Also enclosed you will find correspondence from me to Father Lang responding to his letter.

It seems that I am being contacted by more churches in connection with doing the same sort of things that I did with you. If that proves to be the case, there may, indeed, be some value in grouping together and working as one rather than as a disparate set of individual parishes. I will keep you advised as to this.
